



Hepatitis B Vaccination Protection

The Hepatitis B (Hep B) virus can cause life-threatening disease in humans. Hep B is transmitted through exposure to blood and other potentially infectious materials.

Any workers exposed to blood or other potentially infectious materials risk contracting Hep B. Since Individual Providers (IP) may have occupational exposure to Hep B, Consumer Direct Care Network Washington (CDWA) offers the Hep B vaccination series through local Health Departments at no cost to you.

You will receive a Hep B Vaccination Declaration task in Workday.

- Read the Declaration carefully.
- Select either **Decline the Vaccination** or **Be Vaccinated**.

Do not submit task until downloading the authorization form.
